

6. ANGMERING

Olders Charity School

Founded in 1680 under a £100 bequest of William Older to Thomas Olliver. Rebuilt in 1853 to designs of S.S. Teulon at expense of W.K. Gratwicke. In 1965 the school became St. Margarets C. of E. (Aided) School and moved to new buildings. The old school buildings are now (1978) a Branch Library.

The items in sections E6/12, 13, 14 together with 19/9-12 were deposited by the Headmaster in May 1982.
