Angmering: Older's Charity (Aided) School
Maintenance

With reference to the Managers' recent claim for a maintenance contribution on Form 48A Schools, I note that the receipted account includes the following items which would appear to be the Authority's responsibility:-

- 'Repairing six lead pipes burst by frost - £1.10.0d.
- Repairs to one lavatory seat.
- Lock to cupboard in school.
- Clearing drains from Lavatories to cesspit on 3 different occasions.'

Regarding the clearing of the drains between the School House and the Cess-pit, this would seem to be the sole responsibility of the Managers and cannot, therefore, be included in the maintenance claim as the School House does not form a part of the school premises.

I am therefore returning Messrs. Ballam's account and should be glad if you would kindly obtain from them separate statements showing the actual apportionment of cost of the Managers' and Authority's items. If you will then arrange with the Headmaster to submit a four-part requisition made out to the Managers, and with the account portion completed and certified, I will arrange for the full cost of the above items to be reimbursed.

On the receipt of the amended accounts, I will then forward them to the Ministry of Education in support of the amended claim.
