BRIEF STATEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION AND FINISHES  
-----

ROOFS:

These are constructed in timber, the high level roofs having a 10° pitch and eventually to be covered in copper.

Temporarily, the first stage roofs may have to be finished without the copper, in order to keep within cost limits.

The lower roofs, nominally flat, but actually having a fall sufficient to ensure drainage, give access to clerestory windows for cleaning, etc., and are finished in 3-layer felt with flat asbestos tiles to give thermal protection and a walking surface for maintenance traffic.

## WALLS:

These are load-bearing brick and / or block.

Facing Bricks - Newdigate Handmade clamp stocks.

## WINDOWS:

Metal casements in Timber frames.

## FINISHES:

WALLS - Are generally plastered.  
Emulsion paint at high level,  
gloss paint in lavatories and to  
dadoes.

Pin-up boards are provided extensively in all  
Classrooms, etc.

FLOORS - Are generally in Thermoplastic Tiles,  
Quarry Tile in Lavatories, etc.

WINDOW BOARDS - Are generally in Quarry Tile.

FITTINGS:

Classrooms - These are to have workbenches, sink and bookcase units built in, and under-bench storage units will be supplied as required by the Education Authority.

SHREWSBURY

A fully-shelved cupboard is included in each Classroom.

SERVICES:

Heating is from an oil-fired boiler to radiators and hot-air units.

Hot water will be supplied by local hot-water units to the Lavatories.

Power-points are provided in the Classrooms, etc., for teaching purposes, and elsewhere for amenity and maintenance use.

Radio points are provided in all teaching rooms.
